COMMENTS: Join us as we explore a corner of the Eastern Townships that is only a one hour drive from Montreal. First we visit the **Domaine Côtes d'Ardoise**, the oldest, still operational vineyard in the Quebec. There we will have the chance to taste 5 different wines and wander through an outdoor sculpture exhibition, displaying the works of 80 sculptors. We head into the town of Dunham for lunch at **La Bodega**, a Spanish restaurant, where we will enjoy a selection of 5 tapas, paella and stuffed chicken, dessert and coffee/tea. After lunch, we drive a short distance to Stanbridge East where we will visit the Missisquoi Museum, headquartered in the three-story red-brick Cornell Mill, a grist mill built in 1830. After viewing the main building, we will walk a short distance to Hodge's General Store, built in 1841, and now containing a collection of authentic merchandise from the Great Depression and World War II.
