COMMENTS: The St. Albert Cheese Co-op is one of the oldest co-operatives in Canada, established in 1894. In 2013, their building was destroyed by fire, but they have since rebuilt with more modern facilities. On arrival, we will have time to eat lunch in the onsite restaurant and browse in the boutique which features freshly made cheese, local products and much more. The restaurant showcases dishes with a wide range of cheeses, including many types of poutine. There are also delicious soups, salads, sandwiches, burgers, fish and chips, etc. After lunch, we will have a guided tour of the factory. We will walk along a glass corridor over 200 feet long, offering a view on the production and packaging areas.

We then head to Casselman and the Cassel Brewery. This microbrewery was started a few years ago by a group of friends passionate about brewing craft beers. We will have a complete walkthrough of their process and equipment and of course, tastings of their products.
