

**2024 ITINERARY – M/V CANADIAN EMPRESS  
CANADIAN CONNECTION CRUISE - WEST  
QUEBEC CITY TO KINGSTON (6 Nights - 7 Days)**

- DAY 1 1715 - Pre-boarding commences at **Port of Quebec**  
 1730-1830 - Passenger boarding  
 1800 - Captain's Welcome Reception and Safety Instructions  
 1900 - Depart the Louise Basin to cruise the city's waterfront  
 Dinner - Empress Class Roast Prime Rib of Beef  
 Evening - Cruise to Montmorency Falls (*at Captain's discretion*) and enjoy the beauty of Quebec City at night with complimentary chocolate and liqueurs  
 Evening - Return to port in Quebec City  
 - Soft piano music and lounge services
- DAY 2 0700 - Depart Quebec City bound for Trois Rivières  
 Morning - Shipboard activities  
 Lunch - Comprehensive Safety Presentation  
 1530 - Disembark at **Trois Rivières** for a brief bus tour en route to visit the *Borealis Industrial Museum* for a guided tour  
 1715 - Return to the Canadian Empress

- DAY 3 0600 - Depart Trois Rivières bound for Montreal.  
 Morning - Shipboard activities  
 1515 - Arrive at the **Old Port of Montreal** for overnight  
 1530 - Depart by bus for a guided tour at the *Montreal Museum of History and Archaeology*  
 1715 - Return to Canadian Empress  
 Evening - Fun-loving entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 4 0730 - Depart the Old Port of Montreal bound for Cornwall  
 Morning - Shipboard activities  
 - Transit the St. Lambert and Ste. Catherine Locks to enter the St. Lawrence Seaway system  
 - Pass through Beauharnois Locks (2) Lower and Upper  
 Afternoon - Shipboard Activities  
 Evening - Ship arrives at **Cornwall, Ontario**  
 - Evening entertainment and lounge services

- DAY 5 0915 - Depart for guided tour of *Saunders Power Dam*  
1130 - Depart Cornwall bound for Brockville  
Afternoon - Pass through Eisenhower & Snell Locks (USA) into Lake St. Lawrence

- Pass through lock at Seaway Control Dam Iroquois  
1900 - Arrive at **Brockville** "The City of the 1000 Islands" for overnight  
Evening - Relax and stroll along the park walkways  
Evening - Evening entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 6 0945 - Depart by bus for a guided tour of the *Fulford Mansion*  
1130 - Buses return to the Canadian Empress  
1145 - Depart Brockville en route to Gananoque. Enjoy an extended cruise through Millionaires' Row and experience the beauty of the 1000 Islands  
1700 - Arrive at **Gananoque, Ontario** for overnight  
Evening - Celebration Night with fun-loving entertainment

0930 - Return to Gananoque  
1000 - Debark for guided tour of the *1000 Islands Boat Museum*
