



55+ Voyageurs Companion Policy

The 55+ Voyageurs requires that all travelers travel autonomously. If a member is deemed unable to travel on his or her own by the executive of the club, he or she may be accompanied by a companion who will be responsible for the member on the trip.

In order to travel alone on trips a member must be able to:

- Board and disembark transportation without aid
- Walk the distance required for each trip without aid or use of a wheelchair
- Be able to hear and see sufficiently to enjoy the trip safely and without aid
- Generally be self sufficient throughout the trip.

A companion can be

- A family member or a friend who is able to take responsibility for the traveler

If a traveler requires a companion, space will be made available on the trip at the same rate as for the members of the club. If a companion is required, the trip directors must be made aware at the time of registration of the member to ensure space on the trip for the companion.
